

Operation Uplink & Free Call Days

Operation Uplink **Free Call Days** are an around the clock period where all the calls made from any of the 750+ MWR (SPAWAR) Internet Cafés in Iraq, Afghanistan and Kuwait are free for active duty service members. If the service members do not have access to the MWR (SPAWAR) Internet Cafés or are stationed outside of Iraq/Afghanistan/Kuwait, please provide the unit's contact information (below) and they will be taken care of through other available options. Scheduled dates are provided via <u>Free Call Days</u>, which run midnight to midnight based on Eastern Standard Time.

Uplink is no longer providing phone cards because the program is able to connect an average of 60,000 service members during each Free Call Day. With greater access through750+ MWR (SPAWAR) cafes, Free Call Days and virtual PINs, Operation Uplink is providing more service members with chances to call home than ever before. Through the Free Call Days and the distribution of virtual PINs to hospitalized veterans and service members stationed outside of Iraq/Afghanistan/Kuwait, so far in 2011, Operation Uplink has provided over 800,000 connections!
