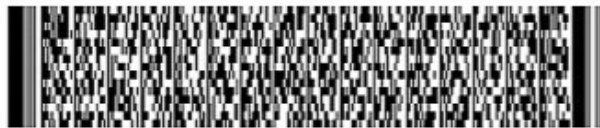

Issuance of your certificate will be contingent upon the results of this review.

PROFESSIONAL CERTIFICATE: For issuance of a Professional Educator's Certificate valid for five years covering PHYSICS (GRADES 6 - 12), the above requirements for a Temporary Certificate must be completed, and a CG-10 Application Form, appropriate non-refundable application fee, and official documentation of the following requirements must be submitted to the Bureau of Educator Certification:

- a passing score on the **English Language Skills subtest** of the Florida General Knowledge Test earned no more than ten (10) years prior to the date of application. By law this requirement must be satisfied within one (1) year of employment in any Florida public school under the Temporary Certificate. Contact your employer for important information concerning this deadline.
- a passing score on the **Mathematics subtest** of the Florida General Knowledge Test earned no more than ten (10) years prior to the date of your application. By law this requirement must be satisfied within one (1) year

of employment in any Florida public school under the Temporary Certificate. Contact your employer for important information concerning this deadline.

- a passing score on the **Reading subtest** of the Florida General Knowledge Test earned no more than ten (10) years prior to the date of application.
